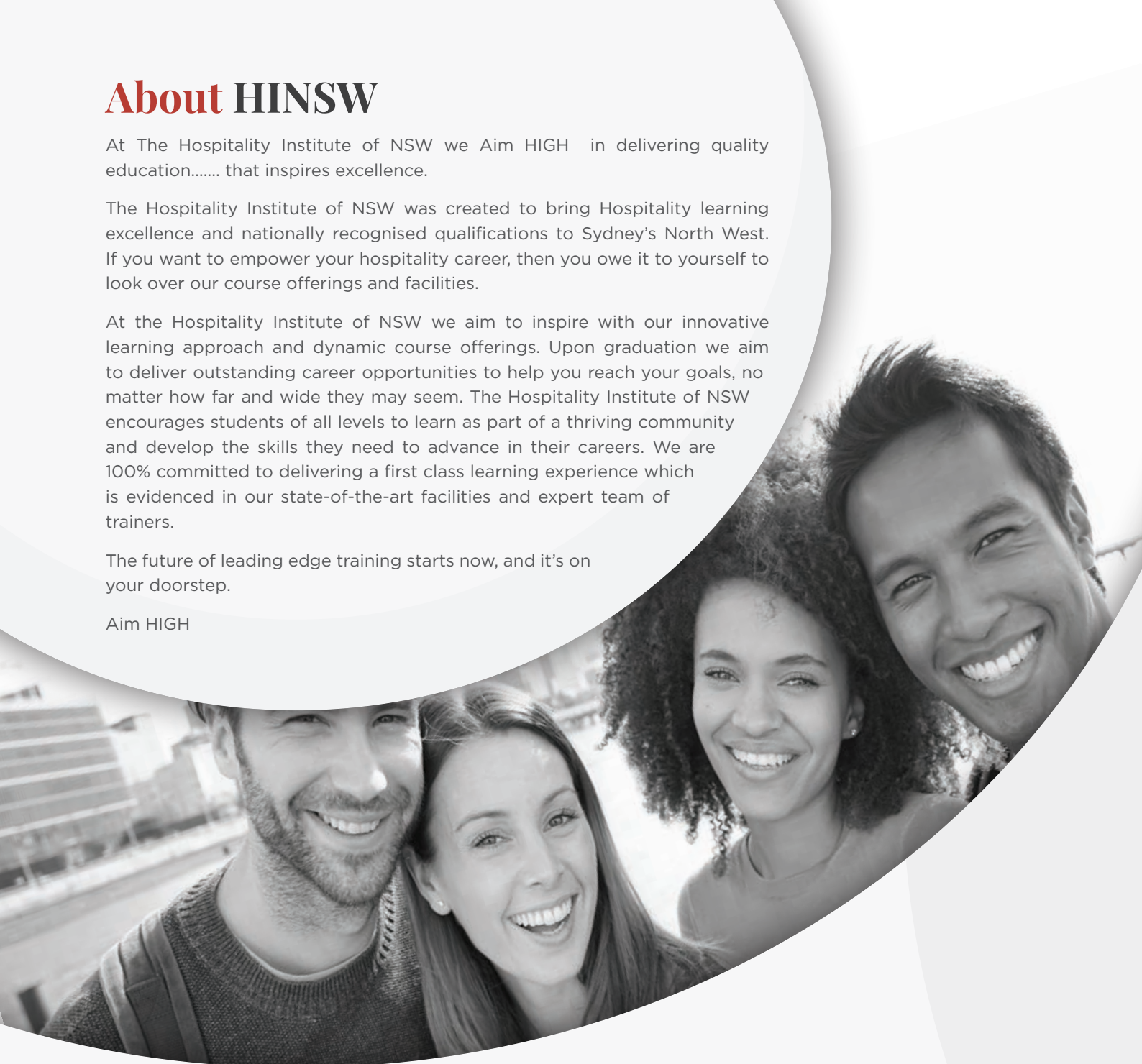

## Course Details

Our CPCCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry course is a mandatory health and safety legal requirement in Australia for all people who are involved in the construction industry and highly regarded in many other work environments. Legislation requires refresher training every five years.

Health and safety legislation describes construction work as any work carried out in connection with the construction, alteration, conversion, fitting-out, commissioning, renovation, repair, maintenance, refurbishment, demolition, decommissioning or dismantling of a structure.

An employer must make sure that anyone carrying out construction work has completed and carries with them an official valid Construction Induction White Card.

We offer a fun and informative one-day course that will provide you with the knowledge and skills to obtain White card certification.

We run regular courses so it is easy to fit the White Card course into your schedule.



## Training Program

All students are required to arrive 30min before the course start time for registration and ID check. Any student who is more than 10min late will not be accepted into the course.

During this six (6) hour course, you will learn the knowledge and skill associated with working safely in the construction industry.

This course is designed to help you;

- Identify health and safety legislative requirements of construction work
- Identify construction hazards and risk control measures
- Identify health and safety communication and reporting processes
- Identify incident and emergency response procedures

Students must bring:

- ✓ Photo identification (licence or a passport)
- ✓ Pen and paper to make notes and complete assessment activities
- ✓ Wear comfortable clothing

There are 3 components to this program:

- Theory training in the classroom
- Practical training in the classroom
- Assessment for both knowledge and skills

The classroom session is a 7hr program including breaks.

## Certification

Student will also be provided with a Construction Induction card (White Card) issued by Safework NSW. This can be used to commence work in any construction/construction related premise.
